Dear Parents and Carers,

School arrangements from 29th June

As I'm sure you will be aware, school looks and runs differently than usual during this period and so, if your child has a place from Monday 29th June, please read the following information carefully.

We have had to work hard in order to safely open to more children and we have lots of guidance we have to follow in order to meet health and safety requirements.

Failure by children and their parents/ carers, follow instructions and safe practice, including late drop off and collection, may result in your child's place in school being withdrawn.

Attendance:

There is an expectation that, if your child has a place, they attend every day just as they usually would. Although school was open initially for emergency childcare, this is no longer the case. We are a school and your children will miss learning if they do not attend.

Friday- Early Finishing Time:

School will be completely closed to all children and staff from 12.30pm on Friday afternoons to enable our cleaners to perform a deep clean of the whole building. This is on top of the extra hygiene measures and extra cleaning hours we have implemented throughout every day. Please check to see what time your child's group will finish on a Friday afternoon.

Uniform:

School uniform should be worn by all children, including school shoes if they still fit your child. Spare trainers can be brought in for forest school and playtimes. It is known that the virus can remain on clothing and materials so we ask that your child wears a fresh uniform each day and would recommend that they take their uniform off as soon as they come home from school. For this same reason, children should not come into school with a bag or book-bag. We will not be sending books or homework home from school.

Lunches:

Children will remain in their own classrooms to eat their lunch and then go out to play in their own identified area. For this reason, school meals will be a packed lunch option and we are working to provide a good variance each day. If you are eligible for a free school meal, (not universal infant free school meals), your child will be provided with a packed lunch in school.

For all other children, they must bring a packed lunch into school in a disposable bag (preferably paper and not plastic) as everything will be collected and thrown away. Again this is to reduce the risk of virus being carried between home and school.

Water Bottles and Snack:

A water bottle with your child's name on should be brought into school on Monday and will remain in class until Friday when the children can bring it home to be washed, ready for the next week. It will be refilled each day in school.

Snack will be available in class if the children wish to have some at break.

There are bound to be slight changes to arrangements as we get used to what works in the new 'normal' but we are looking forward to welcoming more children back to school and just wish we could be bringing them all back.
