Class Isolations

Thank you to the children and parents of Y2, Y5 and Y6 who have all been learning from home this week. *Please remember that if your child is off school because they are isolating, it is because they have had contact with somebody who has tested positive and potentially are infectious themselves. They shouldn't be playing out in the street. Children from isolating classes were riding their bikes outside school today.

When self-isolating:

- do not go to work, school or public places – work from home if you can
- do not go on public transport or use taxis
- do not go out to get food and medicine – order it online or by phone, or ask someone to bring it to your home
- do not have visitors in your home, including friends and family – except for people providing essential care
- do not go out to exercise – exercise at home or in your garden, if you have one

Flu Immunisation

If you haven't returned your Flu immunisation permission forms, please do so as quickly as possible or contact the school office if you need a replacement letter. This year, more than ever, we recommend the children are all immunised to reduce the spread of flu across our school and wider community.

Online Learning

If your child cannot come into school because they are awaiting test results, have mild symptoms or are isolating because a family member has a positive result, your child can access a timetable for their individual year groups which will ensure they will not miss too much of their learning. A new timetable will be posted weekly

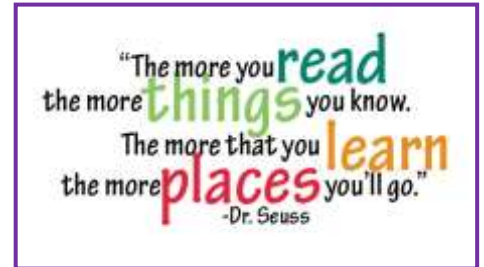
