Good afternoon,

I hope you have all had a good Christmas and New Year- despite everything. We are looking forward to welcoming our children back to school tomorrow.

From tomorrow:

- School will be open as usual- gates will open for all year groups at 8.40am and children should enter from the same place as before Christmas
- Breakfast and After School Clubs will be running but children must be booked in- please contact Mrs Swift to let her know which days you will require for this half term
- End of day arrangements will continue as before for most year groups- However:
 - o Y4 will now exit from the staff car park on Shop Road
 - o Y3 will now exit from the church car park gates on Tithebarn Road

I hope that this will reduce the congestion around the playground gates and encourage parents not to call to their child from across the car park.

Also, please remember that all parents, carers, grandparents and other family members are required to follow government guidelines and do their part in reducing transmission of COVID by:

- wearing a mask when bringing and collecting children from school
- maintaining a safe 2metre distance from all others not in their own family bubble
- leaving the school area immediately after drop-off or collection
- isolating for 10 days from the start of symptoms if you or a close family member tests positive

There is a letter from the Assistant Director of Education on our school website where you will also find home-learning timetables for any children who are isolating.

There are due to be further announcements at 8pm today and I will be back in touch if we need to make any changes to our provision.
