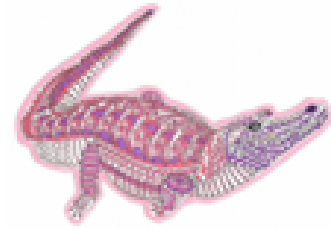

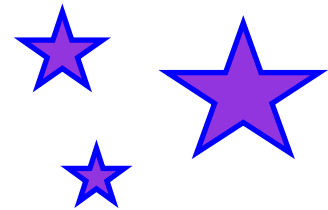
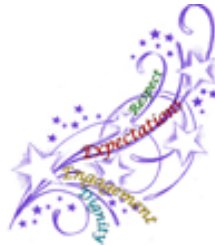

Information

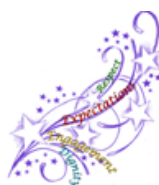
Parents Evening
