Reminder—Reception School Places for September 2023

If your child's date of birth falls on or between 1 September 2018 and 31 August 2019, now is the time to apply for reception class place in school for September 2023. There is no automatic transfer from nursery – everyone must apply between 12 September 2022 and 15 January 2023 by completing the application form of the Local Authority in which you live. Closing date: 15 January 2023. Knowsley residents should apply by accessing the online application portal via the Knowsley website www.knowsley.gov.uk.

Use of Playground

I just wanted to give an update on parents being able to access the school playground at the end of the day. After consultation with staff and Governors, I was informed that the use of the playground was not taken away as a result of Covid safety measures but as a result of the staggered times at the end of the day. It was felt to be a safety issue as some KS2 outdoor lessons were still being taught whilst parents were accessing the playground. We are currently working on ways to prevent this and rearrange timetables to accommodate. We hope to introduce a trial of allowing parents on to the playground shortly and trust that all parents will support us with this transition by following the rules we will be putting in place.

Year 6 SATS tests

The 2023 Key Stage 2 SATs will take place in **the week commencing 8th May 2023**. The 8th May is now a bank holiday so the tests will take place over four days starting on Tuesday, 9th May 2023. Children in Year 6 must be in school on time for these tests.
