School Tracksuit



Details regarding the tracksuit are below. It is not essential that children have these tracksuits this year as we are aware some families have already bought plain navy ones.

Our provider for the new tracksuit is School wear by Lisa and the address is, 275 East Prescot Rd, Liverpool L14 2DB. The new tracksuits are priced at £26.99 each. We realise that parents have already spent out on uniforms for this year so as a gesture, we will give each child a voucher for £6.99 so this tracksuit will cost £20 for this academic year and vouchers will need to be used by December. Children are able to continue wearing a plain navy tracksuit as usual if you do not buy the new school one.
