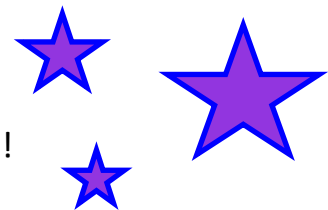

Shining Lights



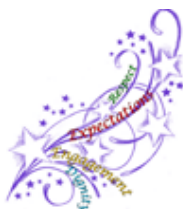
These will be announce in Collective Worship on Monday due to running out of time in this weeks assembly.

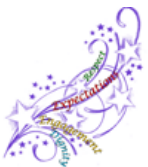
