Foundation Stage—Nursery and Reception **Team Gore**

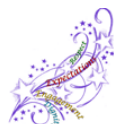
Key Stage 1 —Year 1 and Year 2 **Team Brodie**

Communication and Information

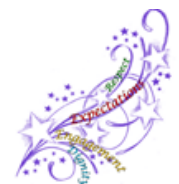

Year 6 SATS tests

The 2023 Key Stage 2 SATs will take place in **the week commencing 8th May 2023**. The 8th May is now a bank holiday so the tests will take place over four days starting on Tuesday, 9th May 2023. Children in Year 6 must be in school on time for these tests.
