I am sure you know that little Olivia Pratt-Korbel had her funeral on Thursday at St Margaret Mary's Church just next to her school. I am told it was a fitting and moving service. Her mother Cheryl bravely gave the eulogy in tribute to her daughter. The mourners were all asked to wear a splash of pink. Next door in the school her former classmates had time to reflect and pray and all the children joined in this and other activities to remember Olivia.

On Monday we will experience the State Funeral of the Queen. This will be full of pomp and ceremony and will be attended by world leaders and televised so all can see and join in.

We continue to celebrate funerals here in the parish too. The grief and pain caused by the loss of a child in traumatic circumstances, or the loss felt by the Royal Family who will bury their mother who was such a global figure, is hard to imagine. I am not sure how we could ever attempt to measure grief but I am sure it would always be unwise to compare our different experiences of grief. What we know is that we will experience grief and maybe every time it is different. This week we have prayed for a young girl, murdered and for a Queen, recognising their loss and celebrating their life. At these moments we can fall back and cling to or trust in our faith, Maybe holding onto the words of Scipture, 'Come you who my Father has blessed; inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world'.
