

Synod - an ongoing process.

It seems some time since we have spoken about our Synod 2020 and the Pastoral Plan for the Archdiocese that emerged from the synod findings and discernment. In the past year various work has continued on the plan which is considering the following areas

- Becoming a Church that accompanies people through life
- Becoming a Church that honours the vocation of all the baptised
- Becoming a Church where synodality is embedded
- Becoming a Church that renews its organisational structures and administers its property to serve its mission
- Becoming a Church where young people and young adults flourish
- Becoming a Church that cares for its priests

This is not just a one off event but an ongoing process that continual leads us to reflect on the church across the Archdiocese, but also at deanery and parish levels. Much work has gone on and some of the areas above are changed and grown and others are still developing. The work on supporting are caring for priests has developed a significant plan and we can hope to share more about this in the near future. Planning the work on young people in the church is taking a little longer
