Pastoral Plan - Caring for our Priests

This week we have a Pastoral Letter from Archbishop Malcolm . He speaks about our pastoral plan following on from Synod 2020 and especially about the theme or caring for priests. It may be helpful to put this into context.

In years to come the numbers of priests available for ministry will be greatly reduced. Alongside of that is the reality of falling numbers who attend or volunteer in our parishes and all that this implies. So we need a strategic look at how things will be in the future.

There are currently 105 Archdiocesan priests. Of these 74 are under the age of 70. (24 are under 50, 15 are between 51 and 60 and 35 are 60 - 69) There are still 31 priests aged 70 - 75+ with a full-time appointment.

This means that in 2030 we are likely to have 74 priests and in 2040 the figure is likely to be 39 priests. In the diocese we have 140 parishes (21 are looked after by religious orders or congregations.)

This is the context in which priesthood is lived out in the Archdiocese and out of which these reflections are emerging.

There is clearly a need to change both for priests and for people. The priests will be looking at renewed ways of working together and supporting each other as well as issues of workload and priests can plan to retire and still keep pastorally active with out the burdens of administration and holing office. We will all have to think what this is telling us about becoming the church we are called to be.

Chrism Mass

The Chrism Mass is held in the Cathedral as part of our Holy Week celebrations. All the priests gather with the Archbishop to renew their priestly vows and also the Holy Oils of Baptism, Chrism and the Sick are consecrated and blessed for use across the Archdiocese at Baptisms Confirmations, Ordinations and for the Anointing of the Sick. It is a very special Mass and a true gathering of the whole Archdiocese. We have booked a coach for those who wished to attend. The Mass is on the evening of Wednesday 5th April at 7.30pm. The coach will pick up at St. John Fisher at 6.15pm and St Columba at 6.30pm. If you think you would like to go please sign up on the sheets at the back of the churches. We will ask for a donation towards the cost of the coach.

Gift Aid

As we come to the start of a new tax year can I ask if you can consider filling in a Gift Aid form if you regularly give to the parish and you pay tax. It is a simple form and your details will be kept confidential. Basically it means that we as the parish can claim from the government an extra 25p for every pound you donate at no extra cost to you. Forms are available at St Columba from Jim or see Fr Michael at St John Fisher.

We also would encourage you to consider making your payments by standing order - it makes financial planning more simple and its also a more secure way of giving. Again forms are available at both churches.

Parish Committee

The parish committee met last week. We reviewed our activities in Lent and checked on our plans for Easter. Looking ahead we also thought we would plan a few more social events for after Easter. We thought about the parish feasts days, agreed that we would hold another quiz night in April (so start revising and brushing up your trivia knowledge now!), and Fr Michael will give a talk and share photos on his time in Ethiopia.
