Synod - and Our Parish, Children and Families

Last week I wrote about the ongoing Pastoral Plan for the Archdiocese after Synod 2020. About a year ago we held an open parish meeting here to highlight some areas we felt we could work on. One element we chose was our work with children and young families. So what have we been able to do here in our parish?

Well since then we have been able to change and develop how families register their children for Baptism and our initial meeting with them. Prior to then the families just filled an application form in and booked in the Baptism date. Now we hold a monthly gathering for parents who wish to have their children baptised. They receive a warm welcome and some basic information about the service and also some information on how they can pray with their child and develop their faith as a family. The practicalities of booking the date are all dealt with at that meeting too. I think it is a much warmer and better way of getting to know the families. Recently after a Baptism here another mother

approached me to ask about having her child baptised. I was telling her about the meetings and the mother of the child who had just been baptised said to her how lovely and welcoming the meeting was and that you even got a cup of tea! It was great to hear that response - recommendation is the best advert!

We have welcomed the Knowsley Catholic Children's Choir to a parish Mass and held our first Christingle children's service before Christmas. *Continued on next page*
