#### **English**

Throughout the Spring Term we will explore these 4 core texts:The Storm Whale-Fiction , Hello Penguin-Non- Fiction, The Elephants Umberalla, Lions-Non-Fiction

We will explore these stories immersing ourselves in the characters and locations including underwater animals and polar regions. We will learn how to consolidate writing CVC words and begin to write simple sentences using a capital letter, fingers spaces and a full stop.

#### Understanding of the World (Links to Science)

Explore the natural world around them .

Describe what they see, hear and feel whilst outside .

Understand the effect of changing seasons on the natural world around them.

Explore and learn about different habitats comparing animals in hot and cold climates and exploring different cultures and ways of life.

### <u>Maths</u>

#### <u>Number</u>

Recite number to 20. Count backwards from 10 and begin to count backwards from 15. Talk about more or fewer than amounts up to 10. Counts objects and actions up to 10. Compare quantities to 10. Subitise 5 objects. (quick recall of amounts to 5) Link number to an amount to 10. Recall number bonds to 5. Understand combining amounts to 10- 5 add 3 is 8 beginning ti understand the part whole model. <u>Shape, space and measure</u> Order items by height, length and weight.

Create and copy repeating patterns. Become familiar with clock hands and face.

# <u>P.E.</u>

Build on fundamental movements of crawling, skipping. Climbing, running, hopping etc. Use core muscles to build strength and core posture. Move with ease and fluency. Develop skills including batting, passing and aiming.

### <u>Oracy</u>

Use new vocabulary in new contexts. Ask questions to find out more. Connect ideas using a range of connectives. Describe events in detail. Retell a simple story of familiar texts.
