

Notification of change of hours for Academic Year 2023—2024

Please see information regarding changes to the school day timings which will start in September 2023.

In England, local authority maintained schools must open for at least 380 sessions (190 days) during a school year. The Government expects that, where not already doing so, state-funded mainstream schools should deliver a school week of at least 32.5 hours by September 2023.

In order for us to meet this requirement, all school access gates will open at 8:40 and close promptly at 8:45. Children will walk straight into class and registration will take place at 8:45. Wake up and shake up will take place in classes. Children will be marked late if they arrive in school after 8:45.

The school day will be as follows.

Nursery and Reception—8:40am to 15:05.

Year 1 to Year 6 children— 8:40—15:15.
