Shape the Change

'Shape the Change' was the title of an important gathering in the Archdiocese this week. Representatives of from parishes joined with staff and others from a wide range of social action groups, charities and local authorities who work across the Archdiocese. The aim of the event was to network and find out what each were doing in relation to three key themes

Food banks, warm spaces and food insecurity

Care for Creation and climate justice

Refugees and Asylum and creating communities of welcome It was good to join together and listen to the issues and find out what is going on to respond to these important issues and thinking about how we as the church as a diocese and locally in parishes can take action too.

Here in our parish we do much to support the work of Nugent, our local food bank and our recent CAFOD action too. One speaker at the event was from the Trussell Trust which is a charity that supports foodbanks. We were told the startling fact that one in seven people here in the UK have experienced hunger simply because they do not have enough resources or money. Sharing information like this can only stir in us to think more deeply on how we can respond to the issue of hunger and indeed the other areas of concern. The gathering was a first step and we hope to be able to share further developments and

A Message for Our Eucharistic Ministers

If you take Holy Communion to a neighbour or family member for a very short time eg someone recovering from an operation for a short time then this does not need to be recorded.
