

English- Bog Baby & Lost and Found

This term children will be focusing on developing their writing skills to use capital letters at the start of each sentence and end with a full stop. They will also focus on using consistent finger spaces between words. In autumn term children will write sentences by saying out loud what they want to write about. Y1 will focus on forming letters correctly starting and ending in the

Science

This term we are learning about the seasons in Science, exploring the way that the weather changes over the year, and how humans and animals adapt their behaviour to cope. We will also be examining how the amount of daylight hours varies over the seasons. We will be looking at the characteristics of different families of animals, and ways that animals can be sorted. We will be learning about humans the

Music

Y1's first unit is called 'Introducing Beat!' We will be exploring how singing and playing together helps us to be friends. After half term we exploring stories from the past while we learn about dynamics and tempo.

Art - Spirals

During this term children will look at spirals in Art. They will learn that drawing is a physical and emotional activity. Year 1 will explore and recognise that when we draw, we can move our whole body. Children will learn to control the lines we make by being aware of how we hold a drawing tool, how much pressure we apply, and how fast or slow we move. Children will draw from observation or imagination

Design Technology - Food Technology

This term Y1 will be making Santa fruit kebabs! We will design, make and evaluate them. The children will learn about food groups and group familiar food products. They will learn how to cut ingredients safely and prepare the dishes safely and

Domestic Church – This term children will focus on Family and God's love and care for every family. Y1 will look closely at how their families love them and how God loves and cares for all of us.

Advent/Christmas – Children will learn about Advent and how it is a time of waiting to celebrate Jesus' coming at Christmas. Children will look closely and learn about the birth of Jesus. Children will recognise that Advent is a time of waiting to celebrate Jesus at

Local area walk

Computing

Y1 will focus on Digital Literacy this term by recognising ways we use technology in our classroom and at home. Maths

In Mathematics this term children will learn the following;

Number: Count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number. Identify one more and one less from any given number. Read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words. Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations

P.E.

Gymnastics– In Gymnastics Year 1 will learn how to lift, carry and use gymnastic apparatus safely. Children learn to travel safely in different ways, at different speeds and levels. They will bounce, hop, hopscotch, gallop, skip, tiptoe and run in different directions.

Outdoor Activities –. In Autumn term pupils will develop fundamental movement skills, become increasingly competent and confident and access a broad range of opportunities to extend their agility,

History - Toys of the Past

This term the children will learn about historical toys and will look closely at toys from the past. They will learn to identify which toys are from the past and which are from the present.
