






P.E

Reading Record – please sign each time your child reads at home.

Spellings – Weekly spelling lists will be send out half termly – we will start spellings at a later date once children are settled into year 1.

Rainbow Spellings – a selection of tricky spellings your child is expected to spell by the end of year 1. This list will be sent home over the next few weeks. We recommend trying to learn 3 a week.

Homework – One activity per week which will not start until a later date when children have settled into year 1. Send out on a Monday and to be returned within a week.

Book Bags

Required 2 days a week

Monday - Reading books will be changed each Monday.

Friday – Spelling test results will be written inside your child's reading record.

They do not have to choose one of these books every visit to the library and many will also have their levelled reading scheme books to take home too.


Share together at home. Discuss new words and ask your child questions about the text.
