








Year 5 : Tuesday and Thursday

WEEKLY

Reading books – books changed Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Children are not expected to change every session but the extra book changes will be timetabled for those who miss the weekly slot. Remember to re-read books to aid fluency.

Reading Record – Three questions per week. Out on a Friday, to be returned by following Wednesday.

Spellings – Weekly spelling lists found in Reading Record. Spelling test on Mondays. Rainbow Spellings – individual spellings (a selection of minimum of 3 practised weekly).

Maths – One activity per week. Out on a Friday, to be returned by following Wednesday. Mix of paper and Seesaw.

TERMLY

Project – one home learning activity per half term. Optional for children. Autumn 1 – Creation/Art Autumn 2 – Jesus is born

Reading Challenge

The children will pick a book from their year group challenge based either in the library or their classroom.

They do not have to choose one of these books every visit to the library and many will also have their levelled reading scheme books to take home too.



Share together at home. Discuss new words and ask your child questions about the text.
