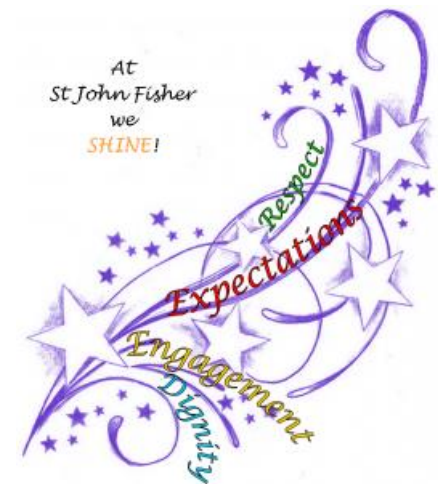

## WEEKLY

**Reading books** – books changed Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Children are not expected to change every session but the extra book changes will be timetabled for those who miss the weekly slot. Remember to re-read books to aid fluency.

**Reading Record** – Three questions per week. Out on a Friday, to be returned by following Wednesday.

**Spellings** – Weekly spelling lists found in Reading Record.

Rainbow Spellings – individual spellings (a selection of minimum of 3 practised weekly).

**Maths** – One activity per week. Out on a Friday, to be returned by following Wednesday. Mix of paper and Seesaw.

**We are aiming for 10 titles to be read from now until the end of the year.**



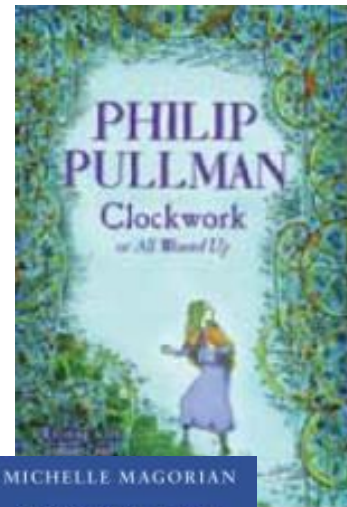
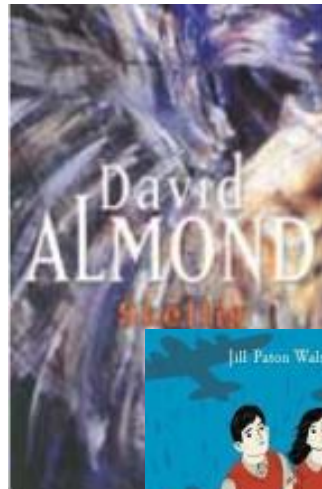
Once they have completed the book, they have an option to choose a fun activity to demonstrate their new understanding. Their teacher will have these available in their classroom.
