


Thank you for all of your kind donations for Children in Need. We will let you know how much we have raised as a school once all money is collected.






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Geography – Helping our children understand their world

Last year we began to use a scheme of work called Oddizzi to support us with the planning and delivery of our geography curriculum. This year, we are developing our curriculum further and tailoring it to meets the needs of our children. We have listened to what they had to say about their lessons, what they enjoy most, and taken on board what they would like to learn more about. This, along with the National Curriculum and our local area has become the core of our new Geography Curriculum offer.

We strive to immerse our children in the real world, and our lessons are designed to enable all of our children to expand their horizons, and explore and understand the people, places, and cultures of the world. We give them a unique view of the world by sharing photographs and videos of people and places, which enables the children to compare the similarities and differences between where they live, places they've possibly visited and places they would like to explore further.

We take our children beyond our classrooms and instil an enthusiasm for learning about the wider world surrounding them and providing the opportunity for them to become confident



global citizens. As the year progresses, we will be sharing our new units of work and how and where it fits in to our curriculum.
