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# French

Every Wednesday, our specialist French teacher, Miss Bramley comes in to school to teach French to the children in Years 3,4,5 and 6. The children are provided with the opportunity to develop their skills in listening, reading and writing, whilst also learning how to apply their phonic knowledge to new vocabulary. They also learn basic grammar which includes feminine, masculine and neuter forms, all of which are delivered through song, video clips and drama.

We strive to prepare our children for secondary school providing them with the skills to communicate effectively and confidently, and every half term each year group explores a variety of topics beginning with numbers, colours and animals right the way through to sports, hobbies and culture.
