A 10 Year Plan?

This last week I spent a 24 hour period with the senior staff in the Archdiocesan Education Department. We were looking at our key priorities for the next 18 months, and a more detailed plan of how we were going to work towards them. In reality we recognised that many issues were a 5 year or even a 10 year programme to achieve where we felt we need to be. Of course in reality in the next 5 or even 3 years, things will change and the longer term plans will be adapted and changed to take in account new realities, but it was still really important to have that long term view and it felt positive to have the plan. This coming week I am at Nugent for our board meeting and we always use that chance to review the 5 year strategic plan for the charity. At the meeting it will be good news to hear about new initiatives and programmes. One area of focus is in supporting children with multiple and complex needs and Nugent are looking at opening new projects and expanding our current work. It is really good to know that the most vulnerable children and young people will be looked after, and more importantly be given the care and opportunities to really flourish. (We have a second collection this week of course to support the work of Nugent and I know you will be as generous as ever). The idea of forward planning is now the norm for charities, and I suppose all agencies and companies too.

This week we have a pastoral letter from the Archbishop about the new families of parishes. In some ways maybe this could be seen as forward planning - maybe a 10 year plan? Like all human organisations the church and the Archdiocese needs to look to the future. Ten years for some maybe seen as a long way off but it is good that we look ahead and plan together, so we can remain the church that we are called to be.
