A Ceasefire for Gaza

With the war in Gaza continually going on it has sometimes even begun to fall down in its coverage on our news. It is almost if, depressingly, we are getting so used to it that it hardly becomes news. The impact of the war is relentless and we need to maintain a voice calling for an urgent and hopefully permanent ceasefire. After the last ceasefire Gaza has witnessed some of the most intense bombardment yet, including in the south of Gaza where hundreds of thousands had sought safety. At the same time, the firing of rockets by Palestinian armed groups into Israel has continued.

On the ground agencies such as CAFOD are still present working via their trusted partners but the poor winter weather has only increased the suffering of the people.

Over 18,000 Palestinians have been killed, 70% of them women and children and the UN estimates that 60% of all housing has been destroyed or damaged with 1.9 million people now displaced. Let us keep our voices to call for peace in Gaza and indeed across our world.

Let us pray for the many people whose lives have been torn apart by conflict in Gaza and Israel. We remember especially those who have died, those who are grieving, the injured and those now

without food, shelter or medical supplies. We pray also for those who have the power to bring peace. May they be touched by a spirit of compassion and kindness.
