Gift Aid

New envelopes are ready for collection for those who gift aid their parish donations. If your box is not there please speak to Jim and Mark at St Columba's or Fr Michael and Dave at St. John Fisher's and we will arrange for a box for you. As we come to the start of a new tax year can I ask if you can consider filling in a Gift Aid form if you regularly give to the parish and you pay tax. It is a simple form and your details will be kept confidential. Basically it means that we as the parish can claim from the government an extra 25p for every pound you donate at no extra cost to you. Forms are available at both churches or speak with the people above.

We also would encourage you to consider making your payments by standing order - it makes financial planning more simple and its also a more secure way of giving. Again forms are available at both churches

Forthcoming Elections - Election Focus on Climate Change

Questions for candidates/parties

1. We need to transition away from fossil fuels if we are to have any chance of halting the climate crisis. How would

you work to ensure that the UK finally ends all new oil, coal and gas projects and phases out existing ones?

2. Some of the world's poorest communities are facing the greatest burden of the climate crisis. With millions of people already displaced as a result of extreme weather events, how would you support working with other countries to raise new taxes from the most polluting industries such as shipping, aviation and fossil fuels to support countries suffering the impacts of climate catastrophes.

More information

In 2009, wealthy countries promised6 to provide \$100bn of "new, additional, predictable, adequate, and accessible" international climate finance per year by 2020. This pledge has only just been met. Even if all 193 countries who signed the 2015 Paris Agreement and committed to lower emissions were to meet their climate pledges, we're still predicted to hit 2.5°C by 2100.We need bolder action – and fast!
