### **Two New Saints**

This Sunday Pope Leo will declare two new saints for the church. Blessed Carlo Acutis was born in London but spent most of his life in Italy. He died in 2006 aged 15. He had a deep devotion to the Blessed Sacrament and he created a website cataloguing Eucharistic miracles from around the world. Carlo regularly explained church teaching to his friends and led many towards a deeper faith by his enthusiasm and own personal witness and faith.

Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati was another Italian born in 1901. He was born into a wealthy family but was always inspired by Catholic social action and charity. He was a keen mountaineer and adopted his own

personal motto of 'To the Heights' reflecting both his sporting and physical activity alongside his great faith. He died young in 1925 after contracting polio while he was caring for the sick himself.


