Season of Creation

We certainly feel that summertime is over and autumn seems to be arriving with a blast. This time of year is a time of harvest and we see changes in nature with the trees and plants around us. I am blessed this year with a bumper crop of cooking apples from the trees in the garden - this year with the hot summer they arrived early and supplied fruit from August but I am still collecting bags full each week; so see me if you would like any to stew or bake into a pie or crumble! The season of creation is a time of prayer too, marked ecumenically by all the Christian churches as a time dedicated to prayer and action for the protection of creation. It is a time to renew our relationships with God our Creator, and with all creation, as we join together in prayer. We give thanks for all that God has made, repent for the damage that we have caused and commit ourselves to take action to protect the earth our common home. Reflecting on this season Pope Leo XIV writes that, "now is the time to follow words with deeds....By working with love and perseverance, we can sow many seeds of justice and thus contribute to the growth of peace and the renewal of hope." In this season I often reflect on the harvest and where much of our food comes from. This includes places like Ukraine and Africa. Ukraine suffering from war and conflict and so many farmers in Africa severely impacted by climate change. Pope Leo's call to follow our prayers with action, to call for peace and real actions to help start to reverse the effects of climate change are needed. And as Christians, we are called to play our part in that call for peace and the necessary action to protect the immense SEASON OF beauty of God's gift of creation and our common CREATION global home.
