Welcome Back

It was wonderful to see all of our children back in school this week looking smart in their new uniforms. We enjoyed welcoming our new Nursery and Reception children and families into our school community.

School Gates—Reminder

All children enter through the same gate each morning. Nursery and Reception parents will be allowed to bring their children to the classroom doors. All other children will walk into school down the ramp on their own as usual. There will be staff there each morning to support our Year 1 children coming into school, as this is a new routine for them. Due to restricted space, parents of children in Year 1 to 6 are unable to walk down the ramp and onto the early Years outdoor area. We still have permission to use the Church car park, so this will be open each morning and close to cars at 8:40 when the main gate opens. It will reopen at 8:50 when the pedestrian gate closes.

At the end of the day, the main gate will open for Nursery parents at 3:05 and for Reception parents at 3:10. The Church car park will close to cars at 3:10, so we ask that Nurse-

ry and Reception remain with their parents at all times for safety. Parents of years 1 to 6 will be welcomed on to the playground at 3:15. The school gates will be closed at 3:25 and the Church car park will open at 3:30. This will enable after school sports club and the after school club provision to use the playground.

This will give parents the opportunity to meet the staff in their child's class and receive information regarding class routines. The teacher presentation will begin at 3:30.
