
If school P.E kit is not worn to school, parents/carers will be called to bring in school uniform for their child to wear that day.

Once they have completed the book, they have an option to choose a fun activity to demonstrate their new understanding. Their teacher will have these available in their classroom.



















SJF Rainbow Spelling Scheme

Rainbow Spelling Scheme




