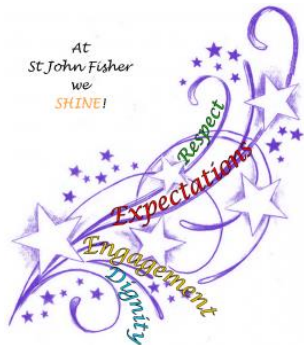

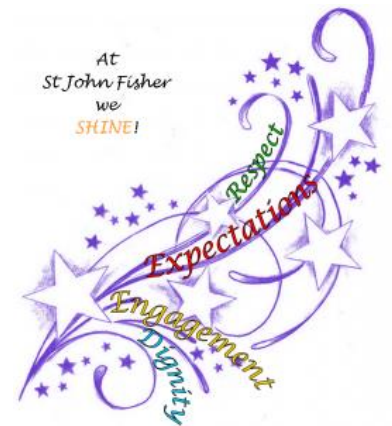

They do not have to choose one of these books every visit to the library and many will also have their levelled reading scheme books to take home too.



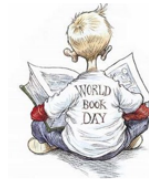
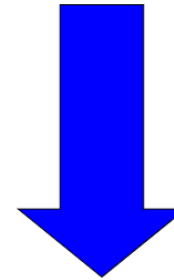
Share together at home. Discuss new words and ask your child questions about the text .

We are aiming for 10 titles to be read from now until the end of the year.

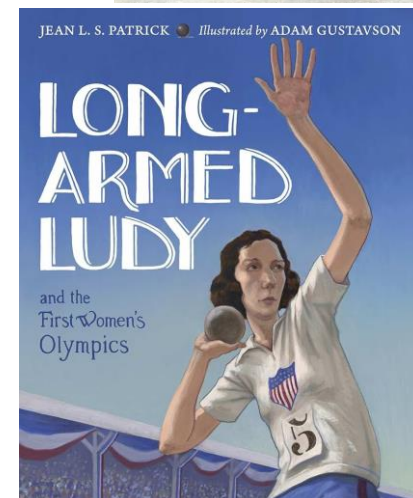
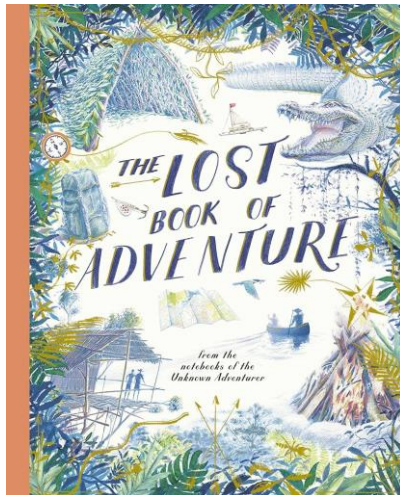
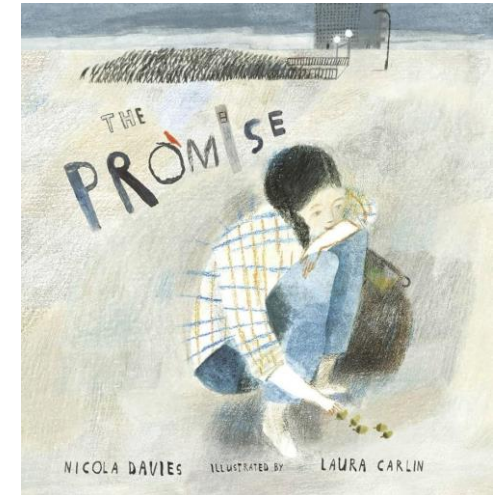
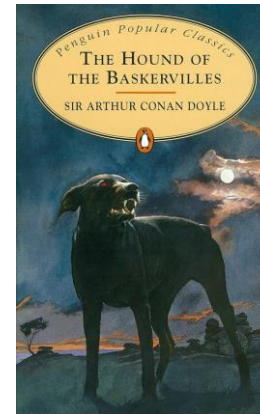
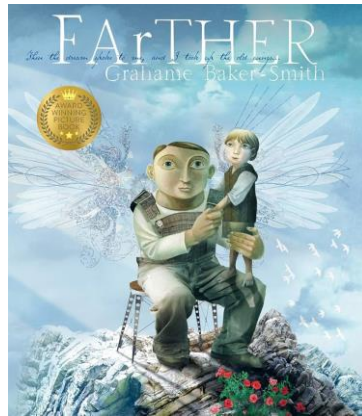


Once they have completed the book, they have an option to choose a fun activity to demonstrate their new understanding. Their teacher will have these available in their classroom.

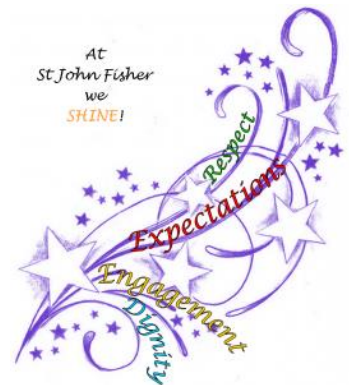
SJF Rainbow Spelling Scheme

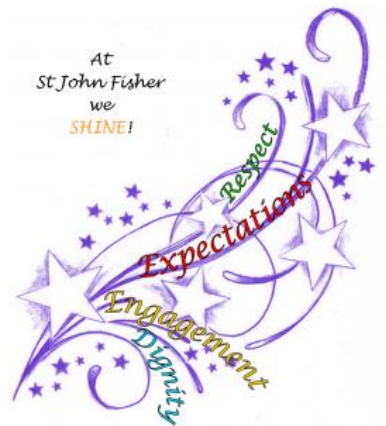
