We are aiming for 10 titles to be read from now until the end of the year.





Once they have completed the book, they have an option to choose a fun activity to demonstrate their new understanding. Their teacher will have these available in their classroom.

















SJF Rainbow Spelling Scheme

They will receive a badge to celebrate completion of that list and move to the next colour.






