This is the theme of the mass lobby of Parliament this week. CAFOD as part of the Climate Coalition are organising this day of action and a small group will be travelling to London to represent our parish at the lobby. We will be asking MPs to back bold, practical action by committing to:

- 1. Deliver vital funding to communities hit hardest by climate change here and around the world
- 2. Cut bills, back UK jobs, and secure a greener fairer future for all
- 3. Restore nature to create a safer, healthier future

CAFOD are especially calling for debt relief alongside action on the climate crisis and its devastating impact on the world's poorest countries, made worse by an escalating debt crisis.

This Jubilee year, Pope Francis called for urgent action on these crises, a call reinforced by Pope Leo. As we take this important message to our elected representatives, we are honouring his legacy.

Another heartfelt appeal that I would make in light of the coming Jubilee is directed to the more affluent nations. I ask that they acknowledge the gravity of so many of their past decisions and determine to forgive the debts of countries that will never be able to repay them. More than a question of generosity, this is a matter of justice.

Parish Coach Trip to Llandudno


The summer coach trip to Llandudno is Thursday 21st August.

Archdiocesan Lourdes Pilgrimage

This year will be a special pilgrimage as we will be marking the official recognition of the 71st miracle of Lourdes - Jack Traynor. Special prayer cards are available at the back of the churches to mark this, please feel free to take one away.



Five coaches of young people take part in the pilgrimage and the young people give of their time and energy to support the assisted pilgrims in various ways, and they take part in the official pilgrimage prayers of Lourdes alongside their own programme of social and spiritual events.

As always, the young people will be willing to take petitions to Lourdes and light candles there for your intentions. Please place your petitions in an envelope and pass them to Fr Michael before the pilgrimage (leaving 23rd July). Donations for candles to be lit need to be placed in a separate envelope.

Can I ask you to also consider giving to support our young pilgrims. The cost of going to Lourdes is kept as low as possible, travelling by coach and cheaper hotels but even so each young person needs around £1000 to go to Lourdes. We are able to support some who struggle financially, but it is a significant cost. Even a soft drink or an ice cream in Lourdes costs over £3!
