#### **Eucharistic Ministers and Care Homes**

We have two care homes in our parish and we regularly receive requests for a priest or a minister to attend the homes to give residents Holy Communion. It would be good if we could set up a regular rota for when visits could be made. If any of our Eucharistic Ministers would be willing to help out with a rota on a even a monthly or fortnightly basis would you please let Fr Michael know.

#### **Mass Cards and Mass Intentions**

Mass cards are available for sale at the back of both churches. Mass cards are often sent to individuals or to family at significant times such as a death in the family, someone falling sick or a special occasion such as an anniversary or celebration. They are a way of letting people know you are praying for them at a particular time or occasion and have requested a particular Mass to be said for the intention. Mass cards usually have a section for a priest to sign in them as this

Mass cards usually have a section for a priest to sign in them as this means a Mass will be offered for that intention. It is usual that an additional donation is made for the Mass intention.

Mass intentions can of course be also requested without sending a Mass Card. The reason for a Mass intention can be varied as above with Mass cards but also to pray in thanksgiving or to ask for special prayers for a person or a situation.

Our Mass intentions are published in our newsletter each week Please note that when requesting a Mass intention for a particular date it is best to make this request early as sometimes we have a waiting list for Mass intentions and also they are usually allocated up to two weeks in advance.

To request mass intentions please write the name or intention clearly on an envelop and indicate a preferred date, time and which church you would like. Place your donation for the intention in the envelop. We will always do our best to meet your requests but sometimes times and dates may have to be changed due to various circumstances.
