## **CAFOD** and Climate Change

The COP30 United Nations climate talks will take place in Brazil next month and it will be a critical milestone. Ten years after the Paris Agreement, countries will submit their new and more ambitious national plans to reduce emissions and show progress towards their commitments. I was privileged to be part of a group of CAFOD supporters who went to Paris for COP21 to campaign for climate justice. Tension was high but ultimately the Paris agreement gave some hope. But today we must continue to speak out as climate change impacts so much on our poorest sisters and brothers in the world. Realistically though, how much progress can be made when 93% of the most climate vulnerable countries are drowning in debt owed to the richest nations and financial institutions of the world?

Pope Leo in his first letter to us says

'We cannot fail to consider the effects on people's lives of environmental deterioration, current models of development and the throwaway culture. For the deterioration of the environment and of society affects the most vulnerable people on the planet. All the members of the People of God have a duty to make their voices heard, albeit in different ways, in order to point out and denounce such structural issues, even at the cost of appearing foolish or naïve. Unjust structures need to be recognised and eradicated by the force of good'. Dilexi Te, 96-97




#### St Columba's Bonus Ball

We are also to hold a family faith and craft event during Advent on Sunday 14th December. More details to follow.




## **Prisoners Sunday**
