Proposed Parish Coach Trip to Llandudno



Archdiocesan Lourdes Pilgrimage

This year will be a special pilgrimage as we will be marking the official recognition of the 71st miracle of Lourdes - Jack Traynor. Special prayer cards are available at the back of the churches to mark this, please feel free to take one away.



Today Fr Michael will be leading a spiritual and practical preparation afternoon with some of the young people preparing to travel to Lourdes as part of our Archdiocesan Pilgrimage. Five coaches of young people take part in the pilgrimage and the young people give of their time and energy to support the assisted pilgrims in various ways, and they take part in the official pilgrimage prayers of Lourdes alongside their own programme of social and spiritual events.

As always, the young people will be willing to take petitions to Lourdes and light candles there for your intentions. Please place your petitions in an envelope and pass them to Fr Michael before the pilgrimage (leaving 23rd July). Donations for candles to be lit need to be placed in a separate envelope.

Can I ask you to also consider giving to support our young pilgrims. The cost of going to Lourdes is kept as low as possible, travelling by coach and cheaper hotels but even so each young person needs around £1000 to go to Lourdes. We are able to support some who struggle financially, but it is a significant cost. Even a soft drink or an ice cream in Lourdes costs over £3!
