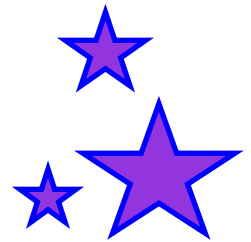

World Book Day: We can't wait to see all of the children's favourite story characters come to life as they dress up.

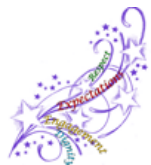
Valentines Dancethon: Children dance all day, to raise money for school fund.

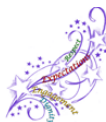
